## **Full-Service Partnership (FSP) Program**



*Providing hope to children and families.*



### ***What is Full Service Partnership (FSP)?***

The FSP Program is for children ages 0-18 and their families who would benefit from a program designed to address the total needs of the child, who is experiencing significant emotional, psychological or behavioral problems that are interfering with their wellbeing. FSP programs provide comprehensive, intensive mental health services for children in their homes and communities.

Children and their families will receive quality services from a team dedicated to working with the child and family as they plan and accomplish goals that are important to their health, wellbeing, safety and stability.

### ***Who is Eligible?***

All new, Intensive Care Coordination (ICC) qualifying children in Tulare County.

Children who are considered at “high-risk,” or experiencing high-utilization of services such as: crisis contacts, medication services, psychiatric hospitalizations, multiple referrals for Therapeutic Behavioral Services (TBS), and have been in services for a duration of time that would lead to improvements in wellness, recovery, and resiliency.

### ***What is different about FSP compared to services offered at other children’s clinics?***

FSP programs are capable of providing an array of services beyond the scope of non-FSP outpatient mental health services to include services provided in the home, after-hours or weekend services when needed, housing and transportation supports, etc. FSP teams provide extensive crisis services and develop plans with families to do whatever it takes (within the resources available and the recovery plan agreed upon between the client and the FSP team) to help clients meet individualized recovery, resiliency, and developmental goals.
